# Kentucky Heart Disease and Stroke Prevention (KHDSPP) Program

- Funding primarily through a grant from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)
- The CDC focus strategies are:
  - ❖ to promote reporting of blood pressure and as able, initiate activities that promote clinical innovations, team-based care, and self-monitoring of blood pressure;
  - ❖ to promote awareness of high blood pressure among patients;
  - ❖ to increase implementation of quality improvement processes in health systems;
  - ❖ to increase use of team-based care in health systems; and
  - ❖ to increase use of health-care extenders in the community in support of self-management of high blood pressure.

# KHDSP Program Funding

- Kentucky Department for Public Health
  - ❖ Federally Funded since 1998
    - Focus dependent on CDC Funding Opportunity Announcement (FOA)
  - ❖ CDC Funding
    - Improving the Health of Americans Through Prevention and Management of Diabetes and Heart Disease and Stroke  
CDC-RFA-DP18-1815 PPHF18
      - ✓ Five Year Cycle (2018-2023)
      - ✓ Currently in Year 2 of 5 Year cycle

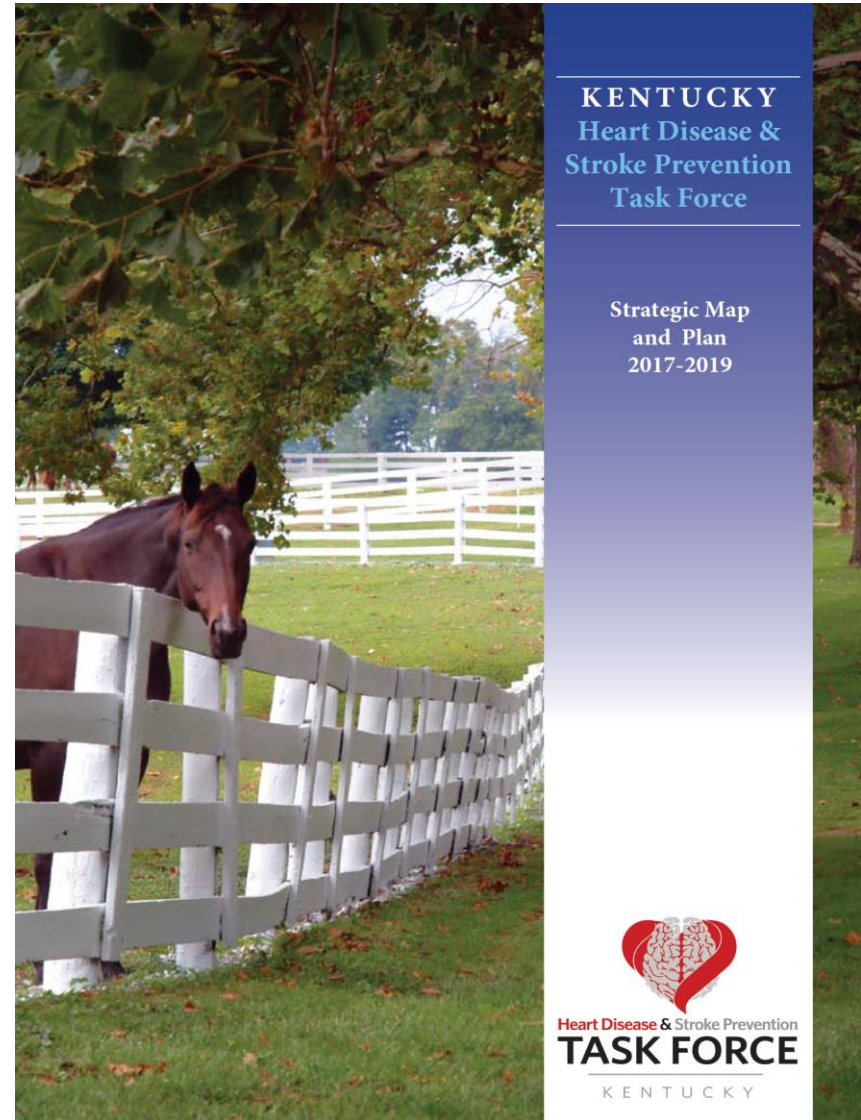

## The Kentucky Heart Disease and Stroke Prevention Strategic Map and Plan 2017-2019

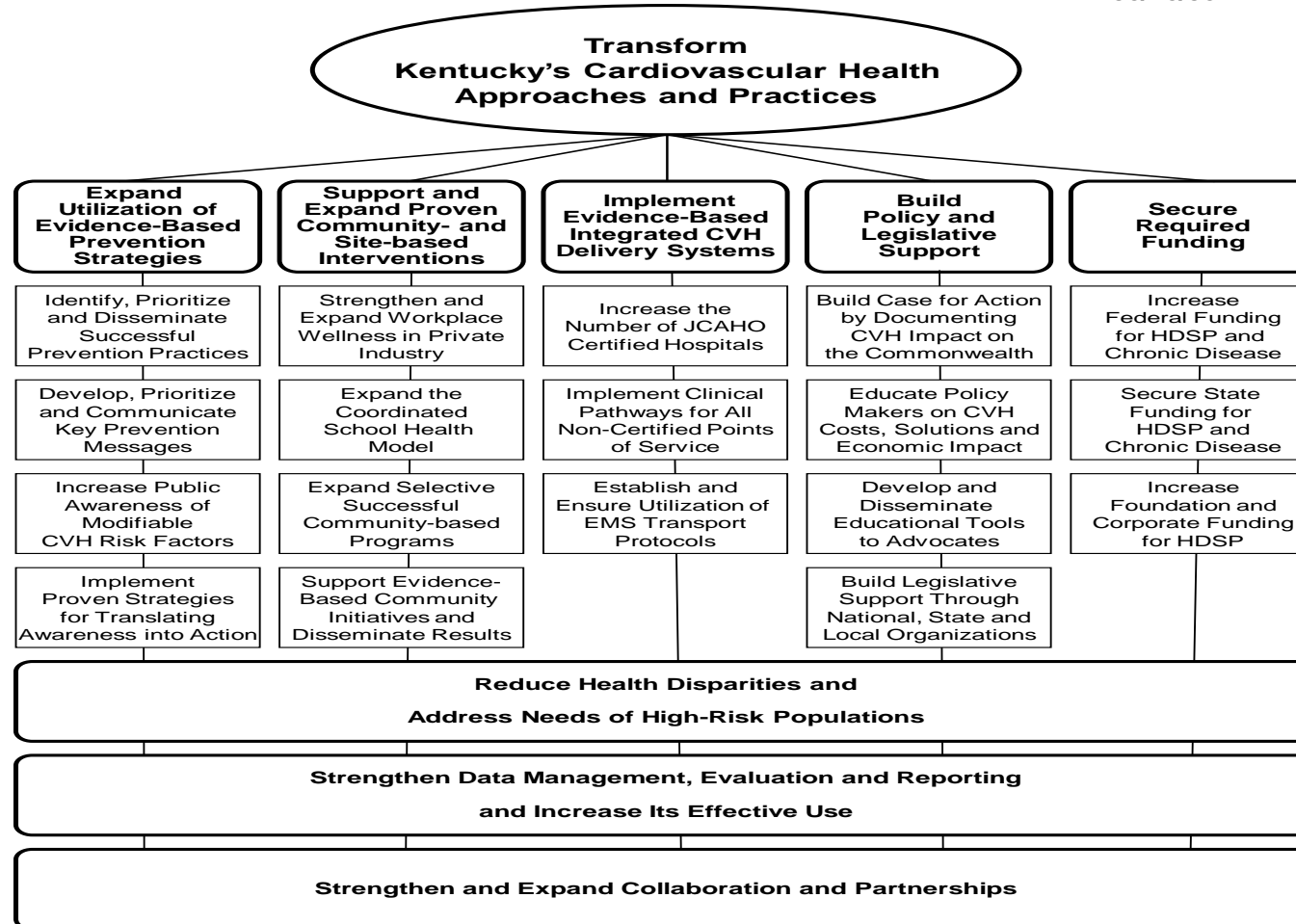
- Outlines objectives and strategies built on the dedication and collaboration among communities and healthcare professionals to address heart disease and stroke in the Commonwealth.



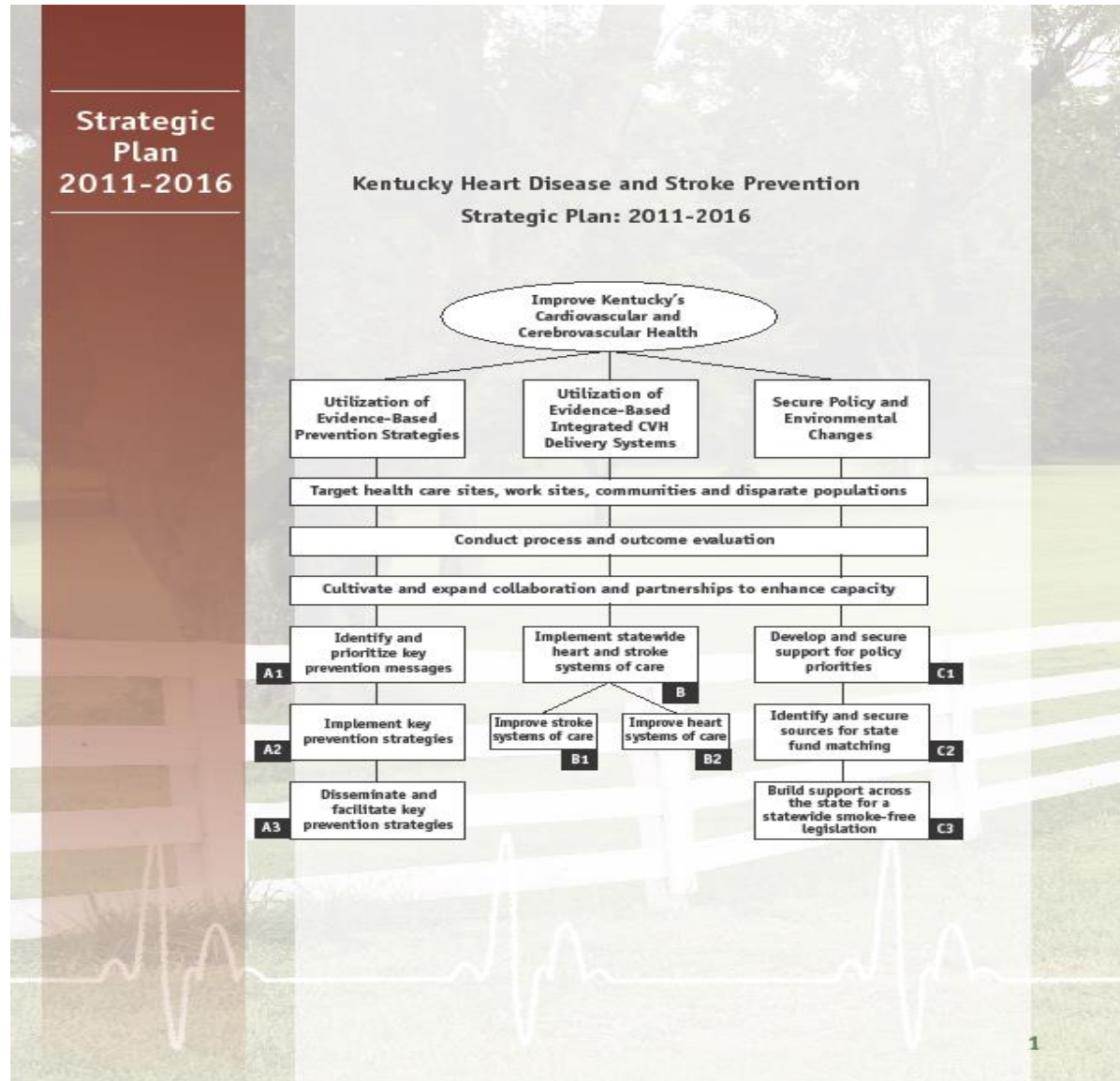
# Strategic Map 2006-2009

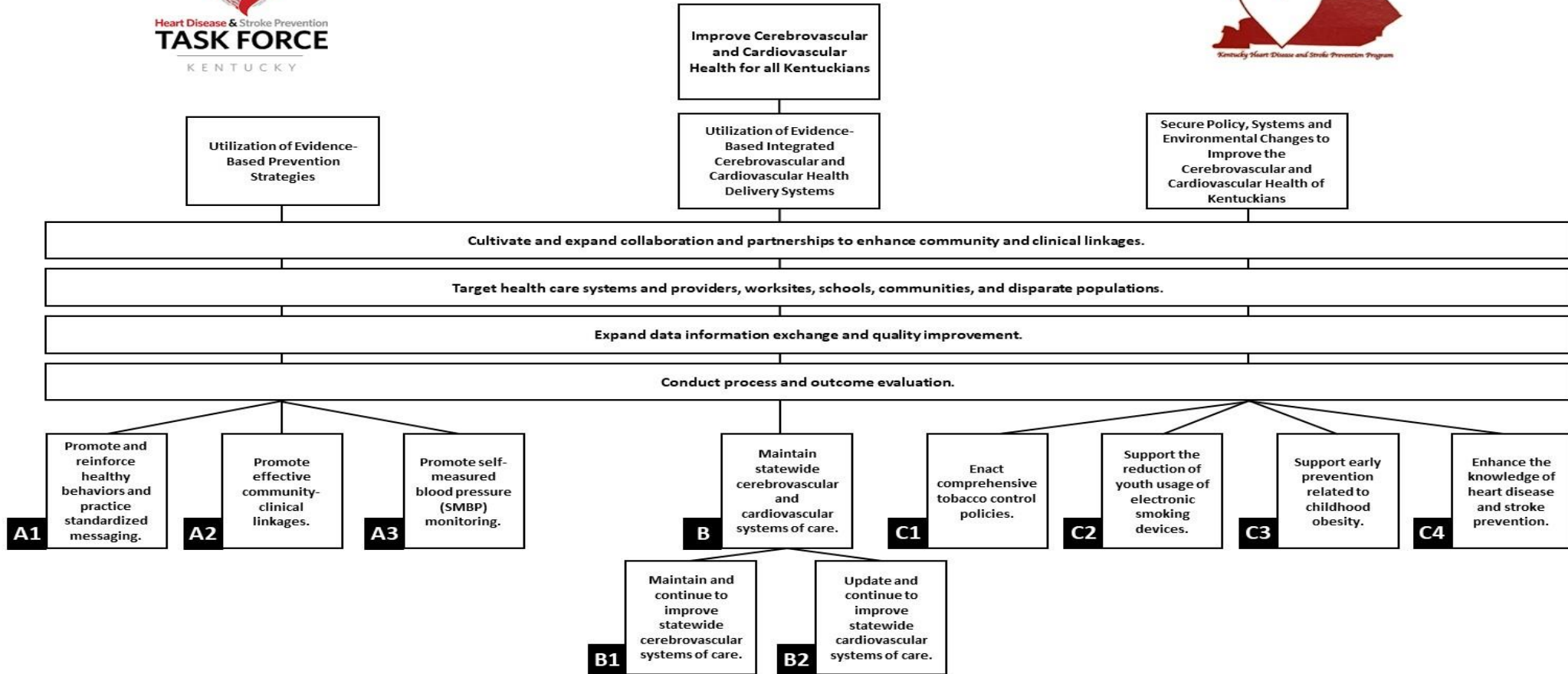
# Strategic Map 2011-2016
