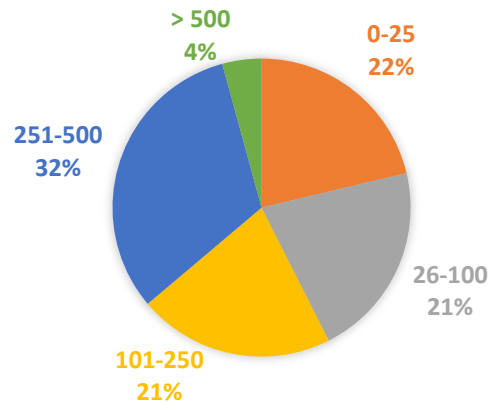


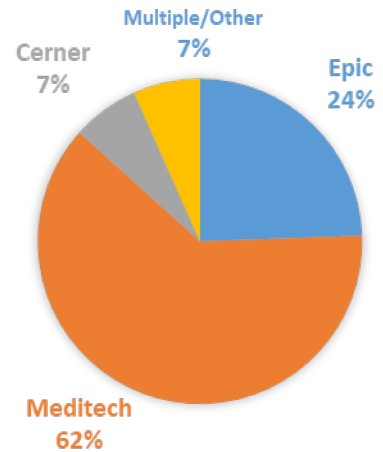

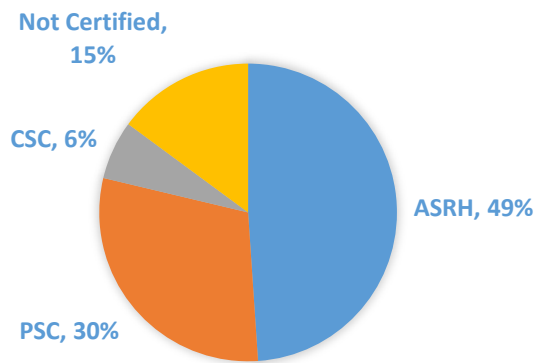
HOSPITAL SIZE (#BEDS)



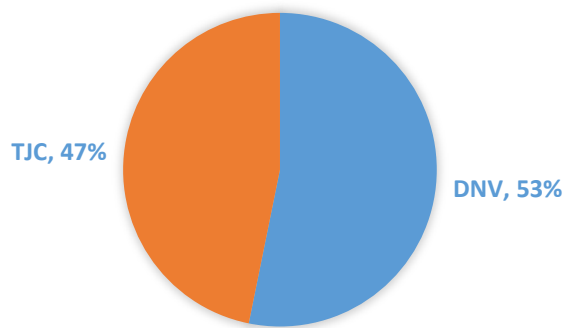

CERTIFICATION LEVEL



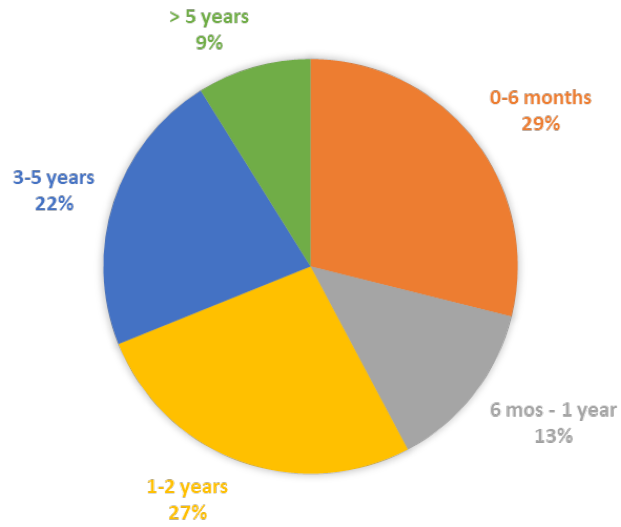
CERTIFYING BODY



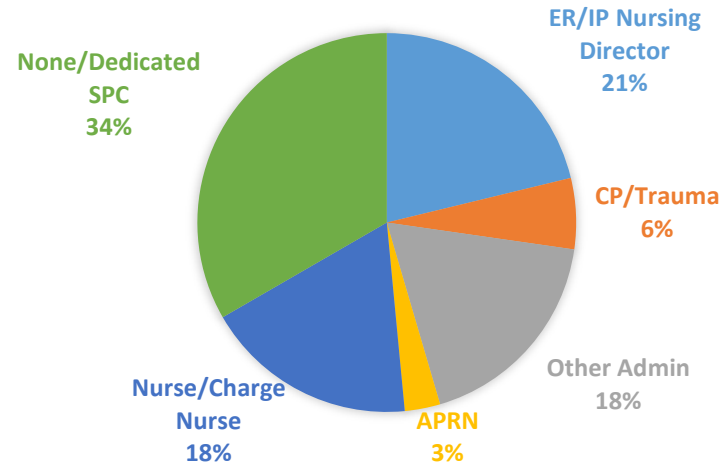

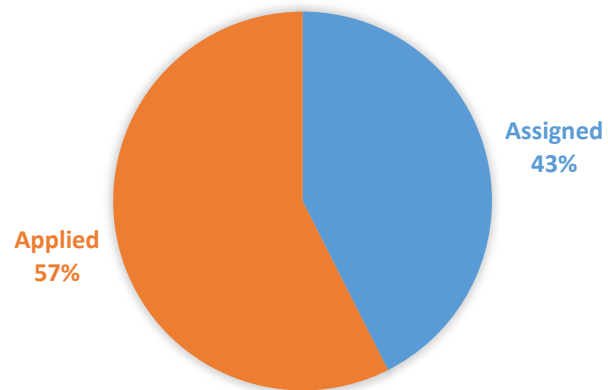
TIME IN THE SPC ROLE

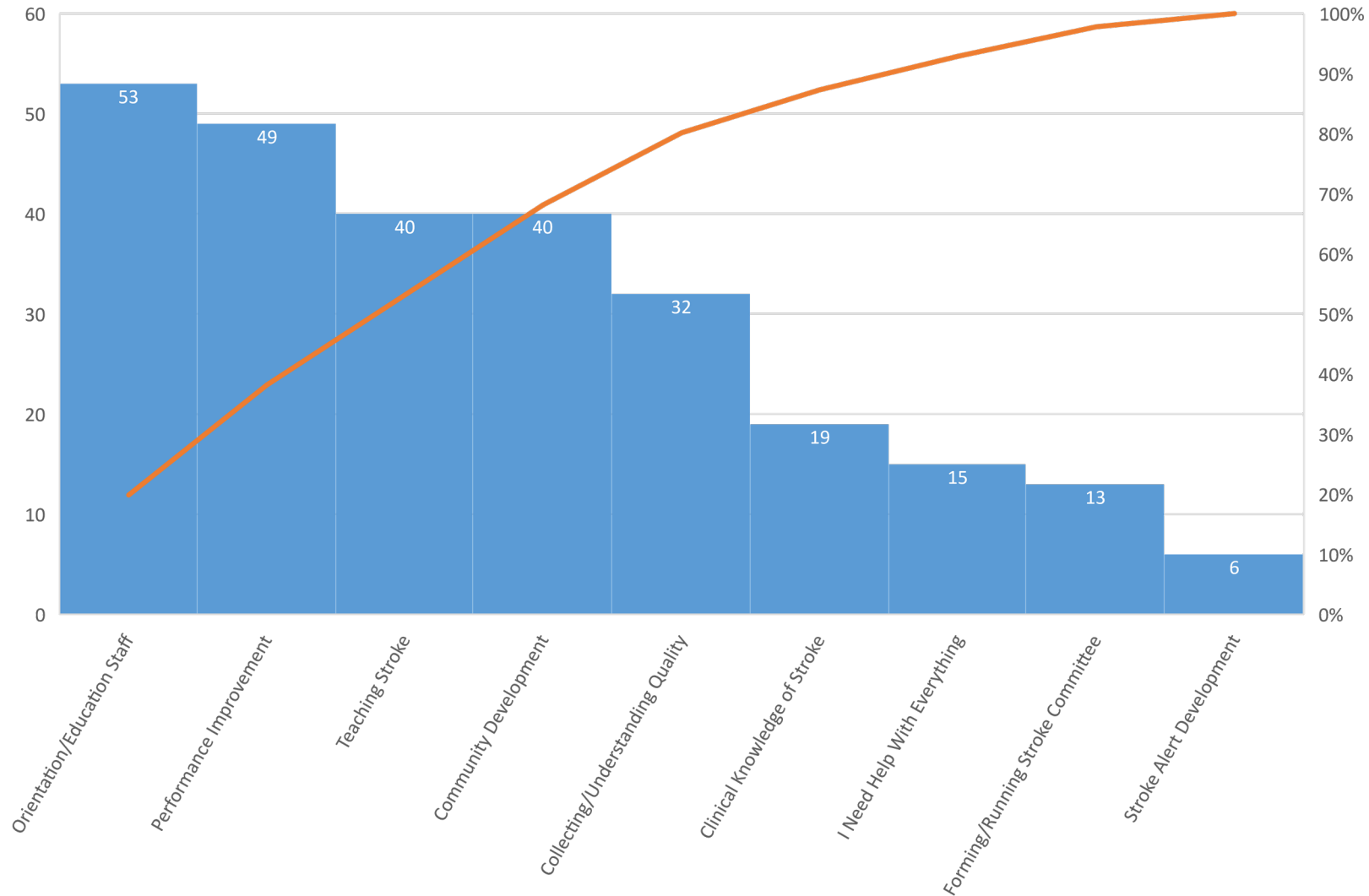

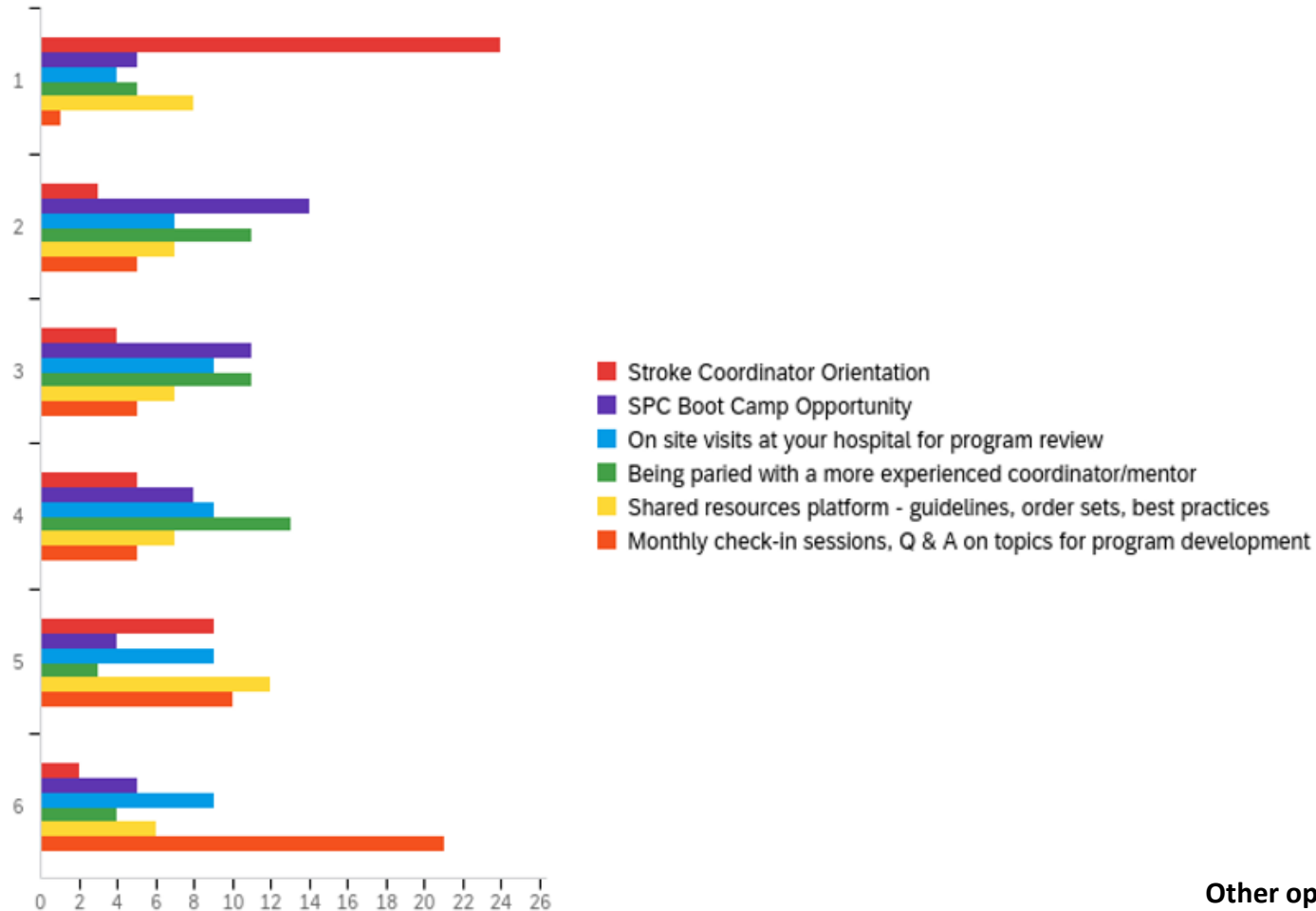
