

Do you need *Quick Stats* at your fingertips? Then don't forget about the On Demand Reports that are automatically run for you which appear on your Community Page of Get With The Guidelines®-Stroke. You can run countless reports in the Reports section of the tool, but if you need some basic statistics *in a hurry*, the Community Page has you covered! In addition to performance data on a variety of measures, you can also scroll down the page to find helpful data on Length of Stay, Records per Quarter, and demographics on the Gender, Race, and Age of your patients. And don't forget the Patient Pathway report which provides data on how patients arrived at your facility, what their diagnosis was, and their discharge disposition.

A variety of topics are covered in these research reports, including the ENRICH trial pertaining to minimally invasive surgery performed within 24 hours of an acute bleed stroke.

Hot Off The Press – 2025 Heart Disease and Stroke Statistics. This annual report is used for monitoring cardiovascular health, risk factors and disease in the U.S. and around the world. This year's report confirms that heart disease remains the leading cause of death in the U.S. and that contributing health factors like high blood pressure and obesity are on the rise. In addition, this year's report shows that someone in the U.S. dies from cardiovascular disease every 34 seconds.
